

Legislation for Combating Single-use Plastic Pollution



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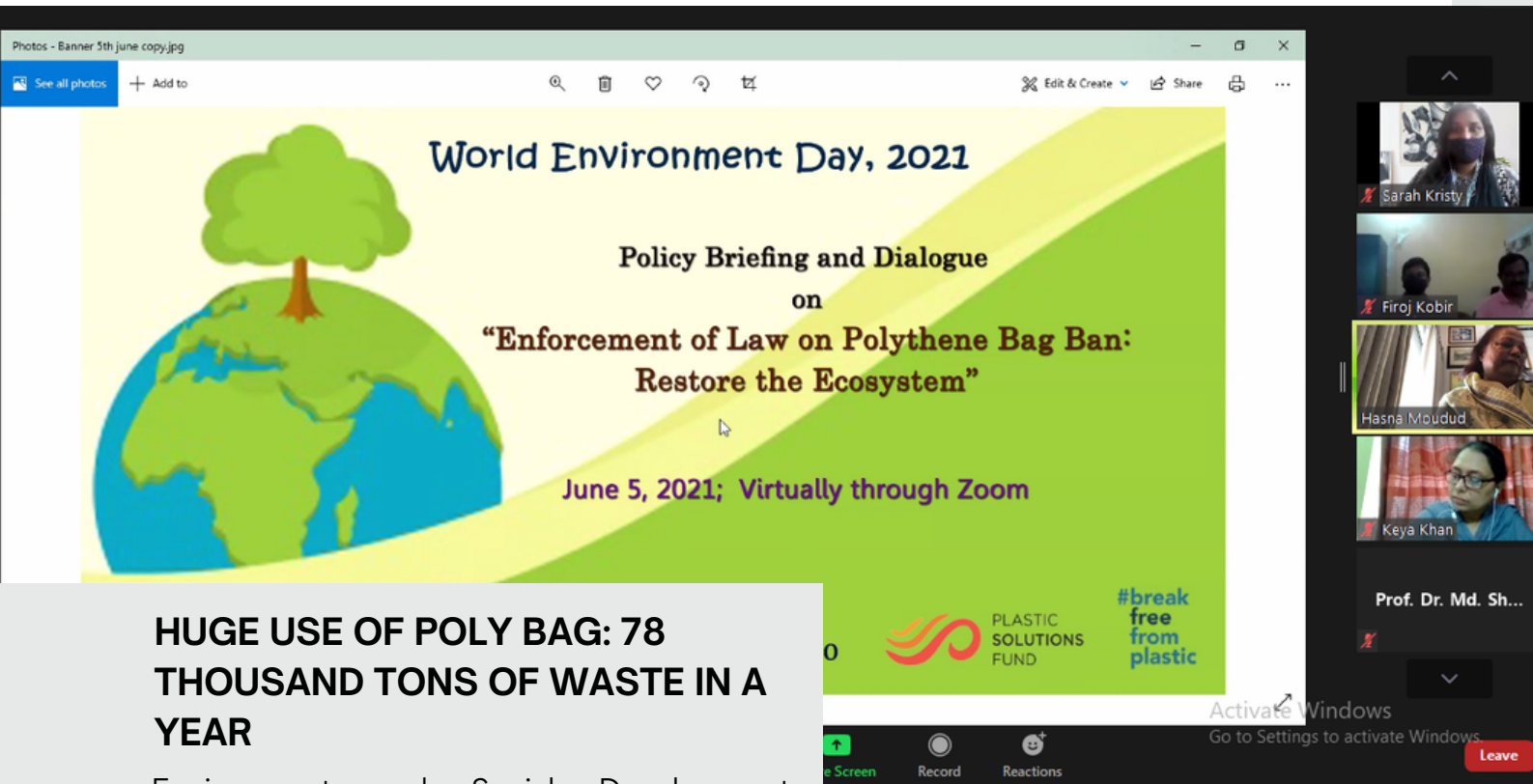
AN EXCEPTIONAL CAMPAIGN BY YOUTH FOR BANNING SINGLE- USE PLASTIC
